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

The Moon goes around the Earth. This is called an orbit. The same side of the Moon always faces the Earth. It takes one month for the Moon to go around the Earth. The Moon is a little more than 200,000 miles from the Earth. It is about quarter the size of the Earth. That means the Earth is four times larger than the Moon. The Moon is a dry land that has millions of craters with rocks and dust



The surface of the Moon is covered with about two inches of dust. The Moon has no air or atmosphere around it, so it does not stay as comfortable and warm like the Earth. The temperature on the Moon is -1700 F at night which is very <u>cold</u>, but it is 2650 F during the day which is very hot. The hottest temperature on Earth is about 1300 F, so the Moon can get over twice as hot!
